Covid & Flu Autumn Boosters

As part of the Covid and Flu Autumn Booster vaccination programme, we held 4 weekend clinics for eligible patients and additional clinics during the week. All were successful, and many compliments received, such as: "Very quick, very friendly". "An excellent service, well organised, thank you to everyone involved".



Over the last 3 months we have had 599 missed appointments. Average of 50 DNA (Did not Attend) / week. As a result, this equates to 99 hours which could have been allocated to patients who needed them.

Smoking Cessation Clinics

As part of our stop smoking service to help patients, we have started a Smoking Cessation clinic which currently runs every Monday. Patients who are eligible, receive a self-book link text message to book their appointment at a time convenient for them. In order to book in, patients will have to click on the link sent to them, which will open in a internet browser, from which appointment times and dates will be visible to choose from. For patients who are eligible but do not have access to the internet, or do not have a smartphone/mobile, our receptionists will book them in manually.

In 2023/24, 53.8% of people using NHS Stop Smoking Services claimed to be successful in stopping.
